



# Be a STAR for a day!

Prospective students thinking about making AHA their high school are invited to spend a day at Holy Angels to experience a full school day here and see first-hand how they fit into the AHA community. An AHA student will accompany them to classes, have lunch together, introduce them to friends and staff, provide information and answer any questions they have.

At AHA, we work hard to ensure that your student's day fits his/her needs and interests. Therefore, we require 48 hour advance notice to schedule a visit so that we can prepare the best possible experience for your student.

## **How do I arrange a visit for my student?**

Please provide us with the following information:

- ★ Your son's or daughter's **name**
- ★ **Date** you would like for him/her to visit
- ★ If you are requesting a **particular AHA student** to accompany your son or daughter for the visit
- ★ A few of your child's **interests**: The Admissions staff does its best to match visiting students with a tour guide who has similar interests and can share insights
- ★ Let us know about any **special requests** you have—meeting with coaches or moderators, specific classes your son/daughter would like to attend, etc.
- ★ Your name and the **best way to contact you** (telephone or email).

**We will confirm your son/daughter's visit, or if we cannot accommodate your request, will schedule another convenient date.**

## **When can my child visit?**

Most school days are available for prospective student visits; however, we strongly encourage students to visit on **Future STAR Days, which are October 13<sup>th</sup>, November 10<sup>th</sup>, December 15<sup>th</sup> and January 12<sup>th</sup>.**

### **What is a Future STAR Day?**

During these days, students will meet in the Annex, along with their parents, who are invited to stay for breakfast along with an informational meeting and personal tour of AHA. Student visitors are paired with AHA students and have the opportunity to experience AHA's weekly "Convocation", which is an all-school gathering to discuss topics ranging from service projects to celebrating student accomplishments. Visitors will be dismissed at 2:30 p.m. and will receive a STARS Spirit item of their choice.

### **Daily Be a Star visits:**

At AHA, we have regular, late start and early dismissal days. Prospective students are welcome to visit during any of these three different schedules. Our "regular" school day begins at 7:50 a.m. and ends at 2:40 p.m.

## Where do I go once I'm at AHA?

Visitors are asked to enter the AHA campus via 67<sup>th</sup> Street and head to the southwest side of the school, toward to Convocation Center. Please park in the "Visitor Parking" spaces provided and enter the building through the Convocation Center doors.

We ask that you park and accompany your child to our 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Parlor at **7:40 a.m.**, where we will get your student started on his/her day with his/her AHA host.

Dismissal is at **2:30 p.m.** from the Parlor.

## Student Visitors:

- \. What to wear: Dress comfortably (jeans are fine) and appropriately. No hats or sagging pants.
- \. What to bring: Bring a book to read in case there is free time.
- \. Lunch: Student guests can select one of three Stars Café entrée options, complements of AHA Admissions. Each entrée comes with a beverage. Any additional food items need to be paid by the visitor.
- \. May ride an AHA school bus for transportation if the visitor rides the bus with his/her AHA host.
- \. Our gift to you: Students are given a t-shirt or a Spirit item of your choice at the end of your visit.
